



Day 7- September 29

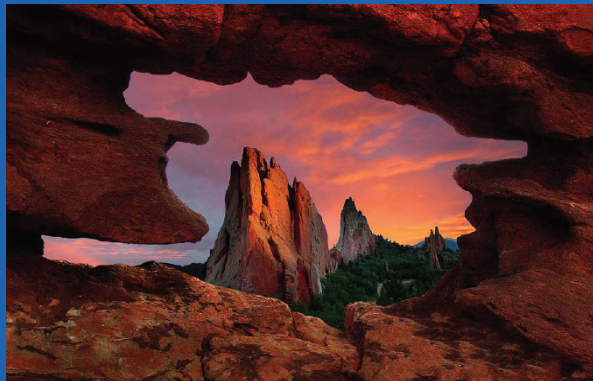

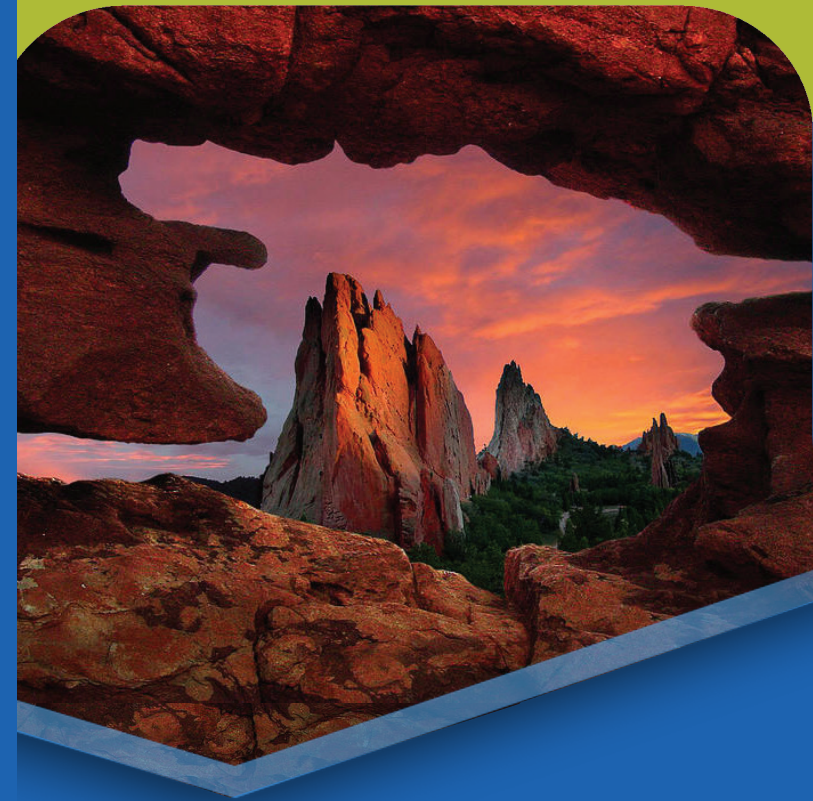

Day 1 - September 23

Today we depart North Dakota on United Airlines and fly to Denver, from Jamestown, for a trip through Colorado's national parks and riding historic trains. The flight departs at 6:20am. There are other flight options available from Fargo and Bismarck. Contact Satrom Travel & Tour for more details.

Upon arrival in Denver, we will have a city tour and lunch prior to heading to Colorado Springs for an overnight at the Holiday Inn and Express. Enjoy a welcome dinner as you get to know your fellow travelers.

Day 2 - September 24

This morning after breakfast, board the Pikes Peak Cog Railway for an incredible ride of 14,115 feet to the top of the mountain. We enjoy a box lunch and spend the afternoon at Garden of the Gods. In late afternoon, we travel to Pueblo for our overnight at the LaQuinta Inn.



Day 3 - September 25

After breakfast, we board a the Royal Gorge Railroad, a historic train of Colorado. Follow the winding, tumbling Arkansas River within the soaring 1,000 feet granite cliffs of Colorado's grandest canyon. Spectacular scenery, certainly not a view you will soon forget.

A stop in Salida for lunch on your own and free time before heading to Alamosa for an overnight at the Comfort Inn and Suites.

Day 4 - September 26

After breakfast this morning, we spend time at the Great Sand Dunes National Park. With a lunch stop back in Alamosa, we then travel through the Rio Grande National Forest en route to Durango for our overnight stay at the Doubletree Hotel.

Day 5 - September 27

The entire day will be spent at Mesa Verde National Park, a little over an hour west of Durango. Upon arrival at the Far View Lodge, a step-on-guide will join us for a three hour tour of the park. When we return, you will have lunch on your own and time to spend at the gift shop. In addition, we will spend time at the visitor center before returning to Durango.



Day 6 - September 28

After an early breakfast, we leave Durango via the Narrow Gauge Railroad to Silverton, where we will view Colorado's mountain splendor not accessible by car. Free time in Silverton for shopping, exploring, and lunch. Overnight in Gunnison at the Holiday Inn Express.
